Opioid Remediation 2025 Frequently Asked Questions

- 1. Can institutions submit more than one application if the projects are distinct? Public entities such as governmental agencies, public schools, educational institutions, and municipal offices can submit more than one application if projects are distinct. There is no recommended number of applications, however, we encourage communication and collaboration across your institution. Non-profits, faith-based organizations, and fiscally sponsored projects can submit one application.
 - 2. Can my organization apply for an opioid remediation grant if we have already received another KZCF grant?

Yes, if your organization has already received another KZCF grant this year, you can still apply for opioid funds.

3. How many applications were submitted last year and what was the average award?

Last year's applications were for opioid remediation mini grants, a different process than our current opportunity. The mini-grants process had 13 applications; 11 were awarded, and the average award was \$21,022.

4. Is there an estimated cap on the grant amount?

For the 2025 opioid remediation grant applications there is no estimated cap. However, please keep in mind that the total amount of funds available this year is \$486,540.

5. Can funds be used for capital projects?

Yes, opioid remediation grant dollars can be used for capital projects as long as such purchases directly relate to opioid remediation. Examples of capital needs can include but are not limited to: building renovation and purchase of equipment. On the other hand, these funds are not a good fit for raising capital to establish an endowed fund.

6. Is there an administrative or indirect cost rate?

Yes, all requests will automatically include a 5% administrative/overhead rate on the budget template. For example, a \$50,000 request should include \$2,500 for indirect costs.

7. What does the opioid remediation grant process entail?

The opioid remediation application requires an application online, a budget, and connection to a priority area from Exhibit E. An application and budget template are both available to support your grant writing process. Exhibit E is also linked on the website.

If awarded, your organization must provide bi-annual financial reporting, one site visit, and one final performance report.
